This is not a food shelf, rather a service that provides emergency rations to those who need them. Prepacked bags of groceries will be available at the church as well as vouchers for a limited amount to cover perishable items at Sunshine Foods. Bags/vouchers can be picked up at the church or we have volunteers in place who can deliver if transportation is a barrier. We've been blessed to serve 11 families thus far which encompasses 17 adults and 14 children. We are humbled that God would use us in this way.
