

Free seeds for all

The Enough Food For All initiative, which was established to reduce food insecurity in southeastern Minnesota is again offering free seeds.

These free seeds are available to individuals and congregations. We ask that the food produced be used to feed persons in need. Each congregation may decide how they use the seeds and the produce of the gardens.

In 2016, the seeds grew gardens at churches, at individual homes, in community gardens, at food pantries and schools. Congregations involved did everything from simply giving the produce to families to preparing meals and then providing them as hot meals or freezing the meals for later distribution. The creativity of the gardeners was wonderful to see. Even the flower seeds we sent to all participants were a joy to the gardeners and the food recipients!
