Special Focus: Developing Leaders

In the next three years, 35 pastors in this synod will reach retirement age. In 2016, this synod only received three new seminary graduates. This means a rostered minister shortage is just around the corner. You can help us turn those numbers around!

To sustain and expand vibrant congregational leadership, we have identified the steps necessary to identify 35 new ministry candidates by the end of 2019! We will seek to guide them into effective leadership in their calls to ministry as pastors, deacons, and synodically authorized ministers.

At the 2017 Southeastern Minnesota Synod Assembly, we invited participants to share the names of people who would be great candidates for ministry. We received a multitude of names, and now we're inviting all of those people to an upcoming discernment retreat. The retreat will be a place for those gathered to truly listen for the Holy Spirit's guidance. For those who do sense a call to ministry, we will do all we can as a synod to encourage them throughout the candidacy process.

Discernment retreats are just one of the ways this synod is developing leaders. With your generosity, we can continue to expand leadership development opportunities in this synod.
